The International Meet is almost upon us. On July 27 – 30, 2011 held in Kenosha, Wisconsin "Hometown for AMC/Nash." This event will be held in conjunction with "Kenosha Homecoming Car Show" and the participating clubs will be AMO, AMCRC, Nash and MOCNA. The featured car will be, the one we all know and love, the Metropolitan.

The headquarters hotel will be the Comfort Suites. As of today, the Comfort Suites are booked so you may have to check with other lodging. There are several hotels and motels in the area.


