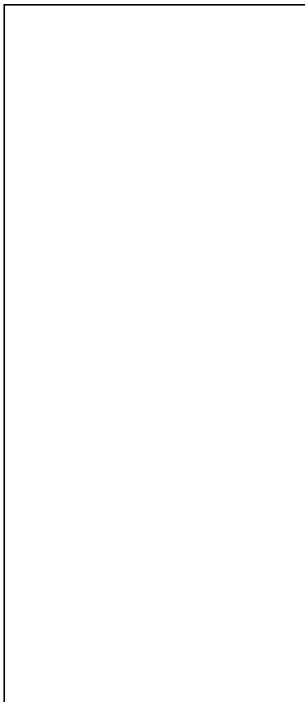
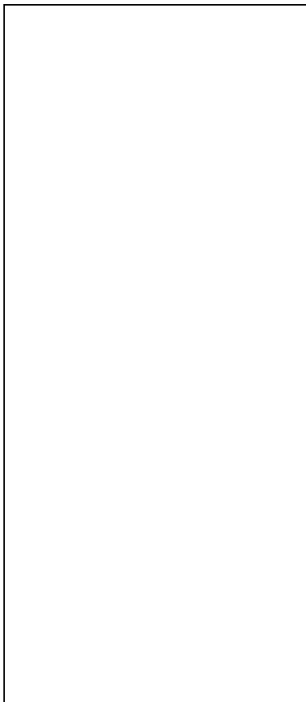
I have taken over the Newsletter for awhile.
